

THE PWU School of Fine Arts and Design welcomes graduate studies applications from individuals interested in obtaining an MA in Fine Arts and Design degree. Applications will be accepted from individuals who have successfully completed a bachelor's degree from a Department of Education / Commission on Higher Education accredited institution, and who possess highly developed, proven skills in visual studies or studio discipline.

STEPS FOR ADMISSION

Step 1. Accomplish MA Fine Arts and Design application requirements as itemized in this document. Your application will be reviewed by the SFAD Admission Committee and shortlisted applicants and will be advised to proceed to step 2 by the Graduate Program Coordinator [GPC].

Step 2. Accomplish PWU Institutional requirements. Expect an admission/non-acceptance email soon after.

Step 3. When application is successfully approved, accomplish the *MFAD Unit Evaluation Worksheet*. This document will be shared upon official admission.

PWU SFAD GRAD PROG REQUIREMENTS

Check all items that you have completed/submitted below:

- Copy of *Application Checklist* in PDF/JPEG (marked and signed by applicant)
- Official Transcript of Records for Bachelor's degree - digital copy.
- Statement of purpose for acquiring the MA in Fine Arts and Design degree (1 page document)
- Statement of plans for a visual art research (2-3 page document in Chicago Manual of Style format);
OR 2 samples of written critical analysis journals or research work related to visual arts (published or not).
- Artist Statement. 1 page. PDF

- Three Letters of Recommendation.
 - * Letter must be addressed to the SFAD Graduate Program Coordinator, Prof. Mervy Pueblo
 - * Emailed directly by the referral person.
 - * Sent to sfadgrad@pwu.edu.ph, with subject heading: F.SURNAME (applicants' Firstname initials followed by surname in all caps)_Reference Letter. i.e. **J.DELA CRUZ_Reference Letter**
- Comprehensive Curriculum Vitae. MUST BE IN College of Art Association (CAA) format (For reference see: <https://www.collegeart.org/standards-and-guidelines/guidelines/visual-art-cv>)
- Portfolio (share access to Google Drive / DropBox link only)
 - * Make a Google Slide / PPT / KeyNote, with a maximum of 20 images only (each JPEG must have 120dpi image quality, but file size should not be more than 1.7 MB per image).
 - * Video clips *for infographic designers, filmmakers, and animators only short video clips (mpeg, 5 min/video only)
 - * Name each artwork per page in this format:
 - Title of Work,
 - Dimensions (or Duration for video),
 - Year
 - Names of collaborators for projects done with a team
 - * Save file on your Google Drive, and share the link along with the other document for submission.
- Interview appointment with the SFAD Dean / Graduate Program Coordinator
- Latest Cambridge/ TOEFL/IELTS exam results. Send PDF/JPEG copy.
(This applies to non-English speaking foreign student applicants only.)

Note: Incomplete applications will not be considered. Completion of the ff. requirements does not mean admission to the MAFAD program. The SFAD MAFAD faculty will convene to evaluate the MAFAD applicant's competency based on the submitted application requirements.

After the review of your application by the SFAD Admission Committee, a letter will be emailed to the applicant to announce if s/he is admitted or not accepted to the PWU SFAD M.A. studies.
