The RDO oversees four other peer-reviewed titles: the PWU Research Journal, Bidlisiw, Sabangan, and Compendium.

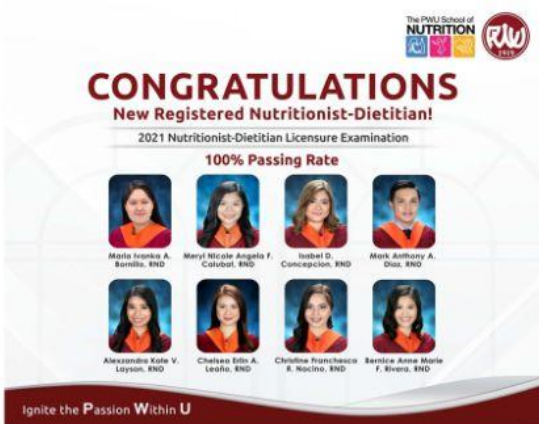

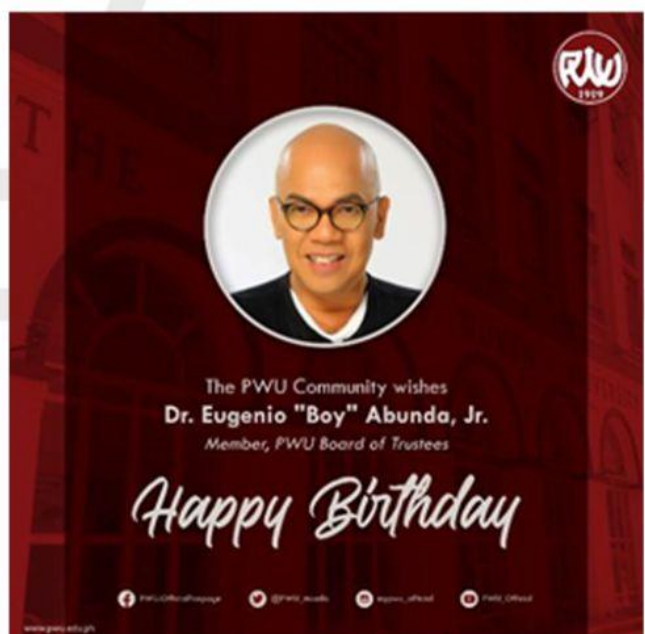

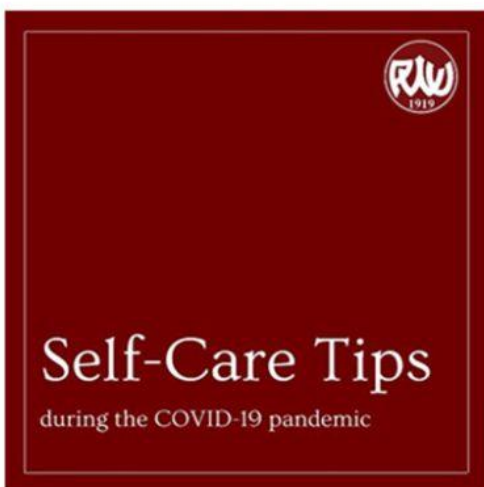

We are pleased to announce the EDWARD & EVA UNDERWOOD CHARITABLE FOUNDATION, INC. is offering an EDUCATIONAL GRANT for students attending Philippine Women's University in SHS at JASMS. This grant shall provide 100% of the Tuition Fees and 100% of the Miscellaneous and Other Fees for those academically qualified and who need financial support. The grant is based on financial needs. Slots are very limited.

Qualifications:

Grade 12 SHS / Working Students who are not studying or who stopped schooling as a first year student due to their situation. Subsidies will also be provided on other school items that may cover books, uniforms, and basic transportation needs.

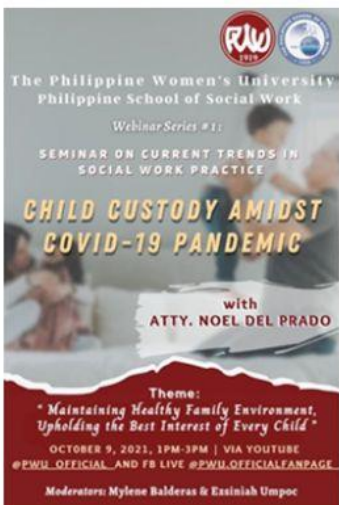



Our second lecture on the complex history of the Avant-Garde with Dr. Thomas O. Haakenson was held last October 14, 2021, with a live broadcast @pwufadofficial FB page.

Understanding the Western Avant-Garde: The way in which the avant-garde developed in the West helps explain the avant-garde's problematic past and its critical potential today. This lecture outlines this development, including the avant-garde's disturbing relationships to colonialism and to revolution.

Dr. Thomas O. Haakenson is an Associate Professor at California College of the Arts in San Francisco, California, U.S.A. His areas of scholarly interests include the artistic avant-garde as well as historical and cultural studies of science and technology. He holds degrees from the University of Minnesota, Twin Cities, and Drake University. He has received awards and fellowships from the United States Fulbright Program, the Social Science Research Council, the Max Planck Institute for the History of Science, the Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst, and the Berlin Program for Advanced German and European Studies, among others. Haakenson is co-editor of the book series Visual Cultures and German Contexts and has co-edited several anthologies, including Jürgen Habermas and the European Economic Crisis: Cosmopolitanism Reconsidered; the volume Representations of German Identity; and also the collection Becoming TransGerman: Cultural Identity Beyond Geography. His monograph Grotesque Visions: The Science of Berlin Dada was published in June of 2021 in the New Directions in German Studies series, and he also edited a volume with Dr. Jennifer L. Creech, due out in early 2022, titled How to Make the Body: Difference, Identity, and Embodiment.
