

# M.FAD Admission Information

The PWU School of Fine Arts and Design welcomes graduate studies applications from individuals interested in obtaining a masters degree. Applications will be accepted from individuals who have successfully completed a bachelor's degree from a Department of Education / Commission on Higher Education accredited institution, and who possess highly developed, proven skills in visual studies or studio discipline.

M.FAD APPLICATION SEASON: October - June.

M.FAD ADMISSION & ENROLLMENT SEASON: June - August

New student applications sent after June will be considered for the next SY applicant in-take. Transferees from the same degree/program are allowed to apply months before a new trimester opens.

### STEPS FOR ADMISSION

- <u>STEP 1</u>. Accomplish Master's degree in Fine Arts and Design application requirements (set 1 to
  3) as itemized in this document. Your application will be reviewed by the SFAD
  Admission Committee and shortlisted applicants and will be advised to proceed to step
  2 by the Graduate Program Coordinator [GPC].
- <u>STEP 2</u>. Accomplish PWU Institutional requirements. Expect an admission/non-acceptance email soon after.
- <u>STEP 3</u>. After receiving the acceptance letter (via email), visit the PWU Portal > Applicants to check your application status, and contact the PWU Admissions office (see below) via email to be assisted for enrollment, but cc. <u>SFAD Graduate School</u>.
  - For accepted students based in the PH, contact Admissions Office
  - For accepted students based abroad, contact <u>Registrar Office</u>, cc: <u>Admissions Office</u>

NOTA BENE: M.FAD is not an equivalence of an MFA or M.Des degree as the enumerated are terminal degrees with 60 plus units/credits. Moreover, an MFA or M.Des degree has specific areas of specialization, i.e. MFA in Painting, M.Des in Industrial Design, etc. Whereas, the area of specialization of our current masters degree is Fine Arts and Design, and M.FAD has only 34 units in total.

  If a designer/ creative director/ art director, submit a Design Position Statement.

- Comprehensive Curriculum Vitae. MUST BE IN College of Art Association (CAA) format
- Work portfolio (share access to Google Drive / DropBox link only).
- Make a Google Slide / PPT / KeyNote, with a maximum of 20 images only (each JPEG must have 120dpi image quality, but file size should not be more than 1.7 MB per image).
  - Video clips \*for infographic designers, filmmakers, and animators only short video clips (MPEG, 5 min/video only) -
  - Name each artwork/project per page in this format: Title of Work,
     Dimensions (or Duration for video),
     Year -- Names of collaborators for projects done with a team
- Latest Cambridge/ TOEFL/IELTS exam results in PDF/JPEG. OR Certification of English Language Skills from PWU School of Education. OR one reference letter from a professor who is an Englishspeaking native that can vouch for your English communication skills.
   \*This applies to non-English speaking foreign student applicants only.

#### NOTA BENE:

- Deadline: the first Saturday of June.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Completion of the ff. requirements do not mean admission to the M.FAD program.
- The SFAD- M.FAD faculty will convene to evaluate the M.FAD applicant's competency-based on the submitted application requirements.

After the review of your application by the SFAD Admission Committee, a letter will be emailed to the applicant to announce if s/he is admitted or not accepted to the PWU SFAD Master's degree, majoring in Fine Arts and Design.
